## BUSINESS RATES REVALUATION – ACTION REQUIRED

New business rateable values have now been published and will come into effect from **April 2026**. Early indications suggest that some businesses, particularly in town centres, may face **significant increases** compared with the 2023 valuation.

While the previous valuation reflected COVID-19 impacts and some transitional support may be available, many business owners may not yet be aware of the scale of potential changes.

We strongly encourage all businesses to **check their new rateable value now** on the Government website [Find a business rates valuation - GOV.UK](#). This will allow time to plan financially for the coming year and consider whether an appeal may be appropriate.

Please note: **the BID levy will not change** because of the revaluation. Further guidance will be shared as more information becomes available.

## TOWN CENTER RADIO SCHEME

Nothing is more important than town centre safety and business communications. The BID's warden is part of a cross-agency initiative to provide security personal across the Town Centre. The 8 CCTV cameras were re-commissioned late November; Police have direct access and already the auxiliary surveillance system is supporting police with investigations as well as acting as a deterrent. New signage is being procured to act as a further deterrent.

Security in the town has many multi-channels. Bognor Regis has an active **Shopwatch radio scheme** managed by [EMS Services](#) who are Bognor based and specialists in event safety and communications.



The radio scheme is £318.60 per year, which gives you a 2-way radio with access to all the other shops and businesses on the scheme, along with the police, business wardens, community wardens, and community protection officers (who are Aruns new officers focused on anti-social Behaviour). The scheme is very active, with information flowing between businesses. The aim of the scheme is to reduce crime and help to keep shop staff and the public safer.
